NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY OF DOGS is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

TELEPHONE, FAXED, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES will not be accepted. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Unsigned entries or entries missing information other than the dog's call name will be returned. **ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed. **ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted. **Entry Fees: \$23 first class / \$15 for 2nd class and / \$12 for a 3rd class, same dog, same day (includes \$3.00 Per Run AKC recording fee).** Make checks payable to 'Columbus All-Breed Training Club' or 'CATC'. Checks must be payable in U.S. Funds. **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check. **NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.** Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of extreme weather, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible or having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. If handlers have a ring conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate you.

TRIAL COMMITTEE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. **All exhibitors must pick up dog waste everywhere on the show grounds.** The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. Any new MACH or PAX titles will be awarded a specially decorated jump bar and a Ribbon.

Novice A & B, Open and Excellent A & B Standard and Jumpers w/Weaves classes in Regular. Also Novice, Open and Excellent A & B Standard and Jumpers w/Weaves classes in Preferred.

OFFERED FRIDAY ONLY

Novice A & B, Open and Excellent A & B in Regular FAST and Novice, Open and Excellent A & B in Preferred FAST.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

MOVE-UPS: Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to **the Trial Secretary in writing**. (E-Mail is acceptable) All move-ups must be received by the Trial Secretary **no later than 6PM on Monday, September 27, 2010**. Day-to-day move-ups over the weekend will be accepted but must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than the day preceding the event (by the end of that days trial).

BITCHES IN SEASON are not allowed to compete. There will be partial refund minus **\$10.00 per day** for bitches in season or for injured dogs if a veterinarian certification (on appropriate letterhead) is received by the trial secretary before the start of the trial on October 1, 2010.

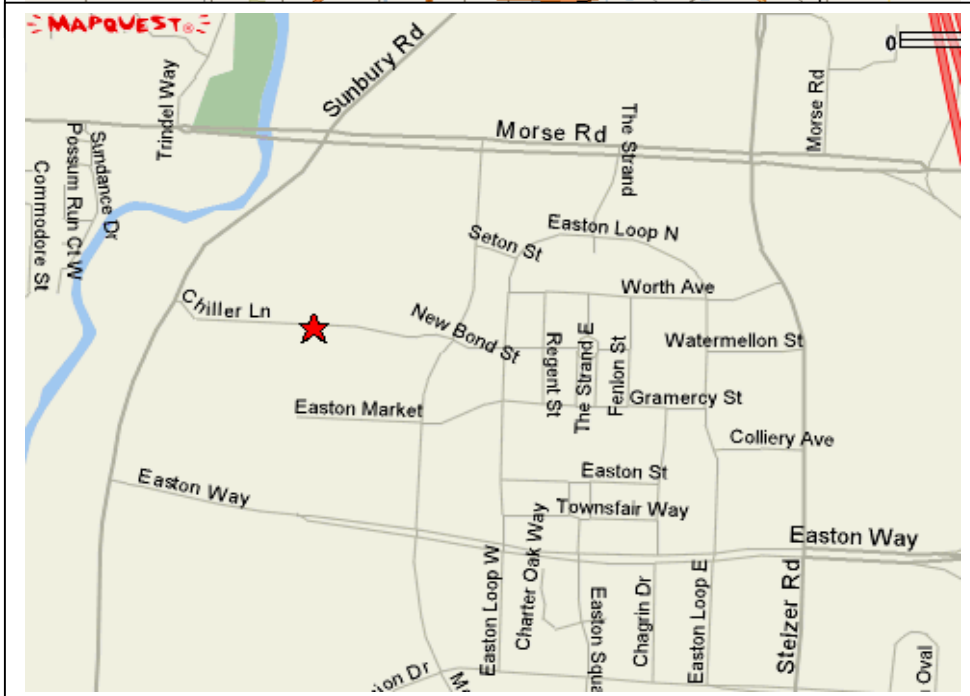
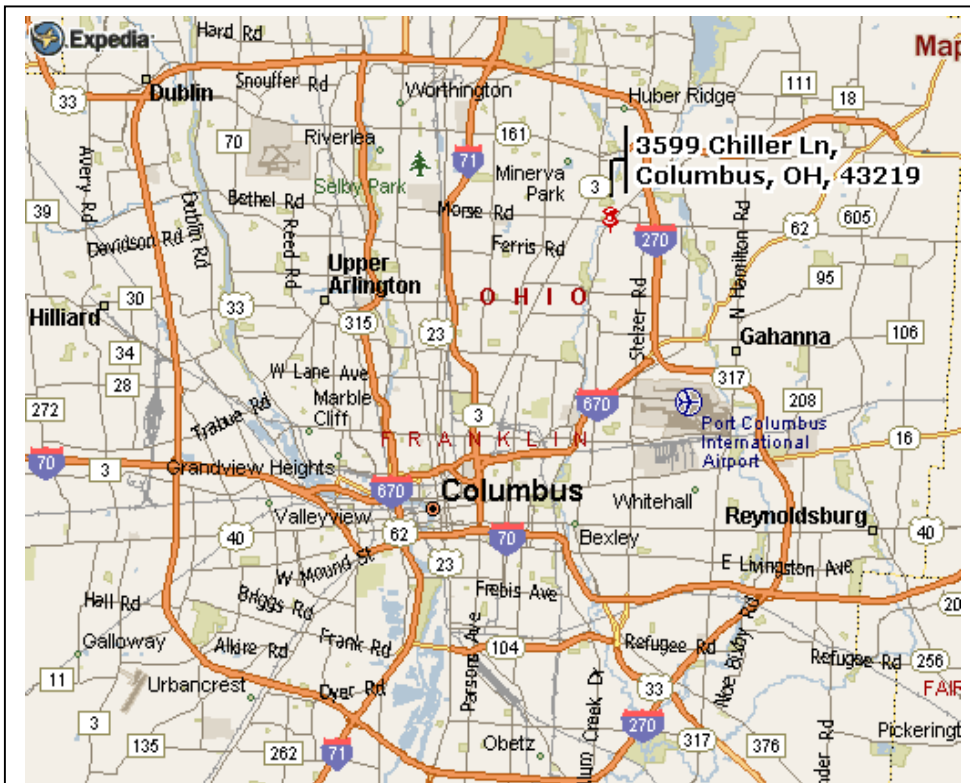

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Food and Concessions: No food or coolers can be brought into the facility. The Sports Barn at Easton will have a food concession on site and all food and beverages must be consumed in the designated eating areas. **NO FOOD** (other than dog food and water) is allowed in the crating area of the Sports Barn.



Directions to the Trial:

From the North: Follow I-71 or Rt 23 South to I-270 in Columbus. Take I-270 East to Exit 33 (Easton Way). Go West on Easton Way to Sunbury Rd. Go North on Sunbury Rd to first street on right. Turn right onto Chiller Lane. The Sports Barn is located at 3599 Chiller Lane.

From the South: Take I-71 North to I-270 in Columbus. Take I-270 **EAST** to Exit 33 (Easton Way). Go West on Easton Way to Sunbury Rd. Go North on Sunbury Rd to first street on right. Turn right onto Chiller Lane. The Sports Barn is located at 3599 Chiller Lane.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
